BCAFN Women Chiefs and Leaders Caucus Meeting – March 24-25, 2026 Travel Policy

General

All BC Chiefs will have guaranteed travel and accommodation support. **If the budget permits**, First Nation communities who send a proxy to participate in the gathering are encouraged to submit their eligible costs and may be reimbursed upon review of BCAFN's Travel Claim Form and confirmation of attendance at the Caucus Meeting.

Please **submit your travel claim within one month (due by April 24, 2026)** following the Meeting.

Meal Allowances

We will provide meal allowances (where necessary and where meals are not already being provided) at the standard Treasury Board rates as follows:

Breakfast: \$29.05 Lunch: \$29.60 Dinner: \$60.75 (if arriving home after 7pm).

Breakfast and Lunch will be provided on March 24 & 25, 2026. **Receipts are not required for meal allowances that are not provided on-site.**

Accommodation

Accommodations can be provided for up to three nights (subject to your travel itinerary)

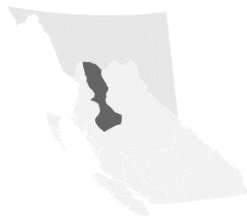
If the room block is no longer available, or if your itinerary requires you to stay outside the venue or outside Kelowna, BCAFN will reimburse reasonable accommodation expenses up to \$180 per night.

Transportation

If you intend to use your car to travel to the Caucus Meeting, BCAFN will reimburse you the number of kilometres between your residence and the Eldorado at Eldorado Resort, at the current regional Treasury Board Rate (\$.60 /km), up to a maximum equivalent to airfare allowances per region. Please include a Google Map screenshot between your residence and the event location along with your travel claim.

Any applicable parking, taxis or bus fare will also be reimbursed with a receipt. If you require a car rental, please contact ada.madam@bcfn.ca to confirm eligible rates.

Flight reimbursement eligibility will be reimbursed based on your region (see below).

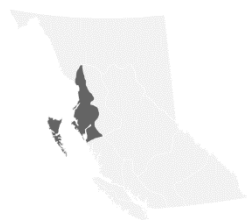


Gitksan/Wet'suwet'en

The region encompasses the communities of Hazelton, Gitanyow, South Hazelton, Kitwanga, Kitwanga, Kispiox, and Moricetown.

Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel for non-remote locations and three days of travel to remote/isolated locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$950 per person.



Haida/Tsimshian/Haisla/Nisga'a

This region includes Haida Gwaii, Nisga'a, and Prince Rupert.

Ferry travel is eligible for reimbursement with receipts. Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to three days of travel for non-remote locations and four days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$1300 per person.

Kaska / Dene / Tahltan / Tagish / Inland Tlingit / Tsek'ene

Including Fort St. John, Fort Nelson, Fort Ware, far as Iskut and Moberly Lake and **all of Stikine region.**

Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel for non-remote locations and three days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$1200 per person.



Kootenay / Okanagan

Including the following communities: Cranbrook and Creston

Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$800 per person



Kwakwaka'wakw / Heiltsuk / Nuxalk / Oweekeno

Kwakiutl District Council, Musgamagw Tsawataineuk Tribal Council and Oweekeno KITASOO-NUXALK Tribal Council

Ferry travel is eligible for reimbursement with receipts. Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel for non-remote locations and four days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$1250 per person.



Nuu-chah-nulth / Coast Salish

The region encompasses the communities of Abbotsford, Agassiz, Ahousaht, Brentwood Bay, Chemainus, Chilliwack Sardis, Duncan, Gold River/Tsaxana, Kyuquot, Ladysmith, Nanaimo, North Vancouver, Port Alberni, Port Renfrew, Powell River, Sooke, Squamish, **Sunshine Coast**, Tofino, Vancouver and Victoria.

- Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel (subject to your itinerary).

Please note, Ferry travel is eligible for reimbursement with receipts for residents attending from communities located on Vancouver Island

- Ferry travellers' applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel (subject to your itinerary) and three days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$850 per person.



Secwpemc / St'atl'imc / Nlaka'ipamux

It includes the urban centre of Kamloops, as well as a number of smaller towns including Merritt, Lytton, Chase and D'Arcy.

Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel for non-remote locations and three days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$450 per person.



Tsilhqot'in / Carrier / Sekani

Including communities of: Alexis Creek, Anahim Lake, Burns Lake, Fort Babine, Fort Fraser, Fort St. James, Hanceville, Prince George, Quesnel, Redstone Reserve, Smithers, Takla Landing, Vanderhoof, and Yekooche.

Applicable meal allowances will be provided for up to two days of travel for non-remote locations and three days of travel to remote locations (subject to your itinerary).

Roundtrip flights and mileage are reimbursable up to \$1250 per person.
